HorNet Campaign Overview

What Is HorNet?

The **Home Owners Rights Network (HorNet)** is a national campaign group focused on improving how roads and public-access land are managed in new housing developments.

Their aim is simple:

“HorNet are campaigning to get local authorities to adopt and maintain the roads and land... instead of the responsibility and cost falling on homeowners - on us.”

Why It Matters

If roads and Public Open Spaces in Shackleton Village are **not adopted** by the local authority, future maintenance - including financial costs - may fall on residents.

Supporting HorNet's campaign may help ensure:

- Fair management of shared spaces
 - Long-term protection of community areas
 - Reduced financial burden on homeowners
